This Sunday is the final day of the Season of Christmas as we celebrate the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. Today, Jesus, the Son of the Father is revealed in the waters of the Jordan. Just over three years ago it went into mothballs with the hope that it could be relaunched. Now, at the beginning of this year it seems a good time to do this. However, it is going to demand members of the parish to join and then commit themselves to working together in outreach to those in need in our community and beyond. Over the next few weeks we hope to provide more information for you to think about this and see if you would be prepared to make such a commitment. Welcome - To Steven Fleming a 5th year student for the priesthood at Oscott College. He is undertaking a pastoral placement in the parish over the next two weeks. We hope and pray his time here will be rewarding and supportive of his formation for the priesthood.

Rosary devotions for an end to the Pandemic - On Monday evenings at 7pm. There will be rosary and devotions live-streamed from the church. Please join via our parish You Tube channel. Stephen, our

seminarian who is currently on placement with us will lead a reflection. It would be good if as many of us as possible could join in this time of prayer together.

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament - Friday mornings at 9.30am and on Saturdays from 10.30am-11.30am.

Finance - I am very grateful to so many of you for continuing to provide your weekly offerings and all those who are supporting by standing order and gift aid. These are such difficult times for so many people. Thank you to so many of you who are making up your contributions over the weeks of lockdown.
