THIS WEEK

PEACE SUNDAY - Today is a World Day of Prayer for Peace. It is a moment for us to intercede for peace in our world, especially in the raging conflicts of the Ukraine, Israel and Gazza. We also pray for an end to warfare in may other places where the conflict doesn't always make the major news headlines. On this day of Prayer for Peace, Pope Francis asks that we pray that the gifts of artificial intelligence be used in the service of humanity and the protection of our common home, and not to further injustice and inequality, or to fuel division and violent conflict.

OFFERINGS AT THE CRIB - Our Crib will remain in church until the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord on 2nd February. This year, the offerings we give at the Crib will be given to the charity, *Friends of the Holy Land*. The charity works to support the very small Christian community that is left in the Holy Land.
